Please read this entire announcement carefully.

- Be prepared to upload the required documentation (proof of age and education) when applying online.
- You will apply for one trade. Research is recommended as trade changes are not allowed after applying or during an apprenticeship.
- Multiple applications will be rejected.
- A confirmation email is sent once an application has successfully been submitted.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- AGE: Applicant must be at least 18 years of age; or will be 18 years of age before January 2027. The following items are acceptable for proof of age.
 - Valid Driver's License, or
 - · Valid State Issued Identification Card, or
 - Birth Certificate with a Photo ID, or
 - Passport
- EDUCATION: The following items are acceptable for proof of education.
 - High School Diploma, or
 - General Equivalency Diploma (G.E.D.), or
 - Official Signed Transcript, or
 - If not yet graduated from high school, Current Official Transcript
- APPLICANTS MUST BE PHYSICALLY ABLE TO PERFORM THE WORK OF THE TRADE.

QUALIFYING TEST: Those who successfully apply will be scheduled to take a two-part written exam consisting of Math (Numerical Ability) and Mechanical Aptitude. The minimum passing score is a 75% composite grade.

INTERVIEW: Applicants who pass the exam will be scheduled for an interview with the Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee.

ELIGIBILITY: Upon completion of the interview, applicants will be ranked by their exam and interview scores and placed on a trade specific waiting list for possible admission once openings become available. The waiting list is good for two (2) years.

TERM: A minimum of five (5) years; includes on-the-job training and classroom instruction.
